Day 1 :Arrive at Paro and transfer to Thimpu (D)-

We board our flight from Delhi International airport and arrive at Paro international airport in Bhutan and by private vehicle take transfers to Thimphu which is the capital of Bhutan. Before emerging ourselves into the modern city of Bhutan-Thimphu our first stop over will be at **Chuzom** which is the meeting point of two rivers Thimphu chu and Paro chu. On the way we will also visit **Tamchog Temple** where oldest Iron bridge in Bhutan is located. Good for photo session. After reaching Thimphu we will visit **Memorial Chorten(Stupa)** built in memory of the third King of Bhutan Jigme Dorji Wangchuk who was called the Father of modern Bhutan. Check in at hotel. Rest of the evening is at your leisure. Dinner at Hotel. Overnight stay in Hotel.

Day 2 : Thimpu Sightseeing(B+D) -

After an early morning breakfast we visit **Buddha Dordenma** which is the largest sitting Buddha statue in the world. After visiting Buddha Dordenma next we visit the **Wood craft & Painting school** .Now we visit zoo to watch extincting species of Bhuta's national animal **Taskin**. later visit **Choki Handicraft** where you can watch how the weaving is done and perhaps try as well.Visit traditional paper factory. Finally we see **Tashi chhoe dzong** which is also called fortress of the glorious religion.The dzong houses main secretariat building and is the throne of His Majesty, King of Bhutan.

In evening we will return back to our hotel for a **GNH Talk** by bhutan's senior journalist over a tea or coffee at hotel conference room.

Later dress up in Bhutanese dress; attend the **Bhutanese Cultural** show and than proceed for dinner. Over night stay in Thimphu.

Day 3: Thimphu – Wangduephodrang - Punakha Transfer via Dochu La Pass (B+D)

After breakfast & check out, we drive to Wangduephodrang, with a stop en route for tea break at **Dochu La pass** (3,100 meters), where on a clear day one can get a spectacular view of the Himalayas. After lunch, we will continue our drive to Punakha, the former capital of Bhutan and visit **Punakha Dzong**, which is noteworthy both for being one of the most beautiful dzongs in Bhutan and also for having been built by the first Shabdrung in 1637. Damaged four times by fire and an earthquake, it has been fully restored by present King. Now you will visit second longest **suspension bridge** of Bhutan, which is built on Po chu river . It connects to the nearby village with Punakha. Walking through this a sheer adventure. Check into Hotel – Evening free to stroll around the region - Night stay at Punakha.

Day 4: Punakha Adventures (B+D)

Post early morning breakfast. get ready for a day full of adventurous activities we have organized for you. First we will do little hiking to visit **Fertility temple**. Now we head for **white water river rafting** for a stretch of nearly 21 Km followed by **Picnic lunch** nearby the river (extra cost Rs. 500/600 per person) After lunch & some rest we proceed to visit sangchen Dorji Lhuendrup Lhakhang (Nunnery) where we will have interaction session with nuns/ lady monks . Later we reach back to our hotel for a good rest & hot dinner

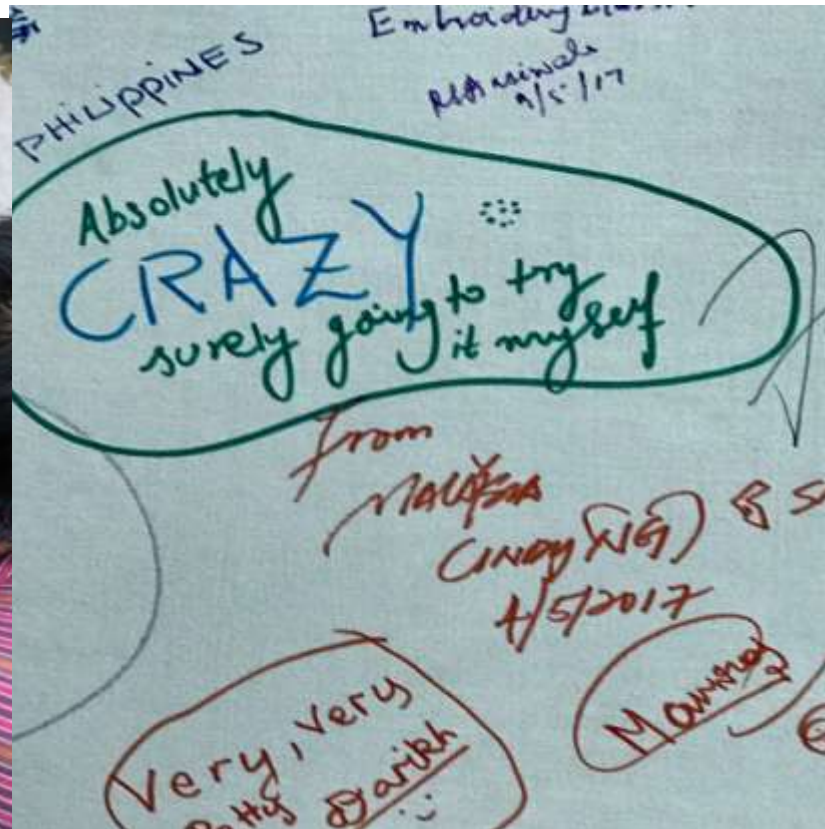

Day 5 : Punakha – Paro Transfers (B+D)

After an Early morning breakfast, Check out Proceed for Paro with a stopover in Thimphu for **Thangka painting Institute** to watch the live demonstration of World famous Thangka Paintings. Depending on time you can also have your lunch at Thimphu. After reaching Paro visit to the **Folk Heritage Museum**. Then we will visit Paro fortress. Check into your beautiful resort. Later stroll around the town of Paro. Dinner at Overnight in Paro



Day 6 : Paro Sightseeing (B+D)

In the morning, we hike to **Tiger's Nest Monastery**, the most beautiful monastery located on a granite cliff high in the mountains. It is approximately 2 hour walk uphill for regular mountain hikers, however who are not used to of mountain hiking it could take an entire day too,. Evening back to the hotel and relax. In case you don't wish to do Tiger nest hiking you can opt visiting **Drugyel dzong** (This ruined dzong is of historical importance. It was built in 1649 by Zhabdrung. On a clear day you have a fascinating view of the white domed peak of sacred Jhomolhari (Mountain of Goddess), **Ta Dzong**: This means - watch tower, which it served as during the 17th century to guard the region from the Tibetan invasion. It was converted to the National Museum in 1968. **Rimpung Dzong**: Means fortress of the heap of jewels. It was built during the time of Zhabdrung (deeply revered to this day as dynamic political and spiritual leader) in 1644. **Kichu Lhakhang** (Monastery): It is one of the two most sacred and the oldest temples in Bhutan. It was built in 7th century by Tibetan King Songtsen Gampo, **Tshendhen Incense Factory in Paro**, was established about eleven years ago. Today, it produces varieties of incense sticks. The owner, Aap Chenchu, is a former monk. Lunch in the town then relax in the hotel. OR you can also opt for Bhutan's traditional hot stone bath (good after a long hike) at an additional cost of INR 800/- per person. Over night in Paro.
